Brandon shared a quote for stainless steel universal joints for underground valve operators at \$380.00 each. They need 3 of them. Karen motioned to approve, seconded by Greg. All voted Aye.

Mitch Altier was here to discuss the new water line project. There was some confusion as to where the lines were being replaced. The new lines will run from Summit Street on S. Columbus o Village limits, and a small portion on S. Market St. This includes High St. Water Tank painting, GAC Filters, Floculator motor upgrades, and Filter Control Valve replacement. The Village has OPWC and EPA Grants for this.

Kelly asked BPA what they wanted to do about the inactive account at Dick Pettits house. Dick uses water there during the spring/summer months, and has it off during the Fall and winter months. BPA decided to keep things the way they are and not make him pay for it year round.

Jim motioned to go into executive session to discuss personnel matters, and Karen seconded. Kelly was asked to stay.

After returning from executive session, no further business was discussed.
